# **Welcome from Millais CAS**



It is our pleasure to launch our Enrichment Clubs programme for Term 2 Spring of the 2024/25 academic year at Millais.

To those new to Millais, CAS is our Personal Development framework focusing on how students can develop their sense of Community, Action, and Self.

We hope our offer will give all students the opportunity to learn new skills, stay active, build positive relationships, and, most of all, have fun. All clubs are run by Millais staff on a voluntary basis.

After-school clubs run until 4pm.

If an after school club is cancelled, we will endeavour to inform parents and students. Please note that students impacted by a cancelled club can always go to the after-school provision (computing room or LRC) until 4pm if required (LRC: Mon-Thurs).

Millais staff also offer SPAs (Supporting Pupil Achievement) sessions after school until 4pm to help students with their class subjects. A separate timetable for this offer will be available on the website at the start of next term. In addition, the Learning Resource centre (LRC) is open 8.05am-4.30pm (Mon-Thurs).

## **Instrumental and Singing Lessons at Millais**

As part of our extra-curricular provision at Millais, we also have a team of visiting music teachers who deliver one-to-one and small group music lessons. We can offer students lessons in singing, drums, piano, violin, viola, cello, double bass, flute, clarinet, saxophone, bassoon, trumpet, cornet, trombone, piano, guitar, bass guitar and drum kit.

Lessons take place during the normal school day for either 20 or 30 minutes on a rotary system. <b>Art Club</b>	A great way for Year 9 students to express themselves creatively while learning new techniques and refining skills learnt in lessons.
<b>Badminton and Volleyball</b>	Non-competitive club. Turn up in your PE kit and use the Badminton/ Volleyball courts.
<b>Basketball</b>	A club to develop your basketball skills, open to students in year 9. As spaces are limited, please speak to a member of the PE staff to sign up.
<b>Basketball – GCSE Invitation</b>	Invite only, specific coaching for GCSE PE students in preparation for their practical component of their GCSE PE course. Paid club via Parent Pay £2 per session.
<b>Book Buzz Club</b>	Come and talk about the book that you read as part of the BookTrust scheme for Year 7 students
<b>Choir</b>	Come and sing your hearts out. We will be doing a wide mix of songs and welcome your suggestions as well.
<b>Christian Lunch Club</b>	An opportunity to get to know other Christians in the school. There will be discussion, prayer, and worship. Bring your lunch!
<b>Code Club</b>	Learning programming in a fun and interactive way.
<b>Dance Club</b>	Develop your dance skills and learn new styles, in the dance studio, PE kit required, no socks or shoes!
<b>Dance Club - GCSE</b>	Session to work on and improve GCSE Dance choreography and set phrases.
<b>Debate and Philosophy Club</b>	Lunch time club discusses ethical issues, philosophy, politics, and current affairs. An area is then chosen from these discussions to inform the debate proposition. After school debate session then brings the previous weeks insights and thoughts to a full British Parliamentary Debate competition. Year 11s and 10s will be eligible to enter the Cambridge and Oxford Schools Debating competitions.
<b>English Homework Club</b>	Drop in for support in completing your English homework, with an English teacher.

<b>EAL</b>	A safe space for students that have English as an Additional Language. So they can express themselves, boost their English and meet other students that speak the same language. We will also discuss key vocabulary of different subjects.
<b>E-Sport</b>	Play esports on Nintendo switches, games include Mario Kart, Smash bros and Just dance.
<b>Football</b>	All year groups welcome. Bring your PE kit, football boots and shin pads meet on the field. Must attend if you want to be a part of the Millais Football Teams
<b>Friday Lunch Club</b>	A drop in club for anyone who wants to come and play games like Avocado Smash, Uno, Dobble and others or anyone who just wants to chat. Bring your lunch!
<b>Geography GIS Ambassadors</b>	Learn how to use Geographical Information Systems including Digimaps and ArcGis. Use your training to become a Millais GIS Ambassador helping other students to use the systems and become better geographers.
<b>Greenpower Cars</b>	An opportunity to build and race an electric vehicle
<b>Hockey</b>	All year groups welcome. Bring your PE kit, shin pads and mouth guards. Meet on the Astro. Must have a gum shield if you want to participate in games at training.
<b>Makaton</b>	Makaton is a unique communication programme that uses symbols (pictures), signs (gestures) and speech to enable people to communicate.
<b>Masterclass (English)</b>	These sessions will cover all elements of the English exams for Language and Literature. The first 40 minutes of each session will be guided input, and the final 20 minutes will be a chance to begin answering an exam question on this topic, which can be completed at home. Full details of each session will be published early in January.
<b>Music Technology Club</b>	Learn how to use the recording studio and all the equipment available in music. Edit and create your own mp3s to take home.
<b>Musical Theatre Academy</b>	We perform all things musical theatre! We'll be working towards a number of productions over the year as well as developing skills in singing, acting and dancing.

<b>Netball</b>	All year groups welcome. Bring your PE kit, meet on the netball courts. Must attend if you want to be a part of the Millais Netball Teams
<b>Netball Club – GCSE invitation</b>	Invite only, specific coaching for GCSE PE students in preparation for their practical component of their GCSE PE course. Paid club via Parent Pay £2 per session.
<b>Poetry by Heart</b>	A chance to take part in a brilliant national poetry competition, students can share and practise performing their favourite poems from memory building confidence and hopefully having a bit of fun.
<b>Science Club</b>	Come and investigate the world around us in science club. There will opportunities to explore different practical science experiments, learn new practical skills and keep up to date with science technology.
