“My first day at Millais was great, even though I was a bit nervous. I am loving here now. It is really fun!”

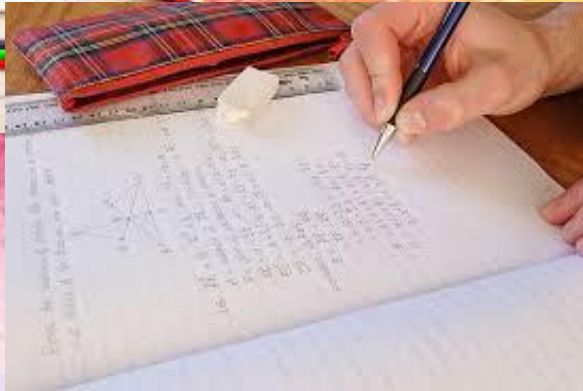
“I have LOVED the canteen so far. I have enjoyed PE and Art.

Top Tips:

- Calm space
- Background noise – some prefer silence, some prefer low level background noise
- Phones for accessing teams is fine but ensure it is not a distraction
- Don't do it the night before
- If taking longer than 30 minutes parents can sign book to evidence required time has been spent

Using Their ELR...

- Parents check and sign weekly
- Each day write the subjects where they are expecting homework
- Use the reminders section for assembly, clubs, bring in kit/ingredients or 'handed book in' etc
